

SUBJECT:	Billboard Sign		

PURPOSE:

To respond to the Civic Properties Commission request for information regarding putting an electronic billboard type sign on top of the Chetwynd & District Rec Centre.

SUMMARY/BACKGROUND:

At the July 28, 2020 Civic Properties Commission meeting a discussion ensued regarding the feasibility of putting an electronic billboard type sign on top of the Chetwynd & District Rec Centre to provide the community with event information along with the current time and temperature.

District of Chetwynd Sign Bylaw No. 913, 2009 does not permit installation of an electronic billboard type sign in the Public and Institutional zone. If the Civic Properties Commission would like to proceed with putting an electronic billboard type of sign on top of the Rec Centre, it would first need to submit a Development Variance Permit application to the District of Chetwynd for Council's consideration to vary the sign bylaw.
