

Sorry for the delay. Responses below:

- 1. The applicant will have to use Hwy 52 to truck the sand to where ever it needs to go. What will be the applicant doing to communicate this to the local residents that will be impacted by the increase in the truck traffic? As part of the provincial permitting process, the applicant has advertised the project in the Alaska Highway Newspaper. Additionally, prior to construction beginning, the Applicant will prepare notification letters that will be dropped off to residents along Highway 52 from the site, north to Highway 2. The letter will have details on the project, including timing, and contact information for residents to obtain more information or submit complaints in the future.
- 2. Will the applicant be using old forestry roads or have to build new one? There are no active forestry roads within the site; however, there is an active oil and gas road that we plan to use the access a portion of the site.
