The Nor' Pioneer Women's Institute in Cecil Lake is requesting permission to host a plant this year at the Cecil Lake Transfer station

Nor' Pioneer WI has been in operation for 87 years, and is affiliated with the Provincial and Federal Women's Institute organizations. We conduct fund raising events as part of our commitment to provide the community with an emergency fund, look after the Cecil Cemetery, organize local social and political information events, and provide support to local organizations such as the Women's Resource Society.

Our plant sale was a very popular event in 2020, and additionally it was a benefit to the PRRD as we advertised the PRRD Spring Clean-up campaign on our sales flyer. This provided the community with extra advertising regarding your campaign, and people appreciated the reminder very much.

Ideally the plant sale would occur for a span of ten days later in May, from Friday of one week to Sunday of the following week. For example, from Friday May 14th to Sunday May 23rd, or Friday May 21st to Sunday May 30th. No plant sales would be conducted on days and times the Transfer station is not open.

We assure you that all precautions regarding safe distancing due to Covid -19 will be in place, as per Transfer Station rules.
