Good morning Bryna,

Our day lodge project has hit a road block due to the unforeseen increase in construction costs. We have decided to withdraw our current approved funding from NDIT of \$50k and re-apply for a higher amount (up to \$300k or 50% of eligible costs).

I am working on this application this week as it is due May 14.

Of course, they require a resolution of support from the PRRD for this application. My question today is this: do you require the completed application when we submit our request?
