Update - Nursing Recruitment & Retention Literature Review and Survey, ADM-HCSC-006 The Communications Manager updated the HCSC on a two stage project that PRRD staff is working on with staff from the BC Nurses' Union and Northern Health on nursing recruitment and retention in northeastern BC. The BC Nurses' Union research team is leading the nursing recruitment and retention literature review, and the first draft will be completed in early April 2021. The review will inform the strategic approach for in-person interviews, as recommended by the Regional Board on February 11, 2021, and tentative completion is summer 2021.
