As a resident and business owner of Pink Mountain I strongly reject the idea of another camp the rooms available in Pink Mtn are never at 100 capacity. Bringing in USA owned camp companies or in fact any non local camp or ANY more rooms is just cutting the throat of the locals and pumping our dollars out of Pink Mtn. We already have old camps littering the highway from FSJ and well into the Sierras . Camps become outdated within a few years and companies just abandon or neglect as the trucking and reclamation is huge. Horizon North on Don Loewens land has set up at least a 150 man camp with no permit. They are pretty confident they can Bullwinkle locals and PRLD. They are not local they don't pay land taxes and it needs to be stopped. I pay close to 32 k a year and use a complete local supply chain that is being suffocated by companies such as Royal (Indianapolis) not right.
