Good afternoon,

The engagement process for the draft *Winter Motorized Recreation Management Plan in the South Peace* has entered week 4 of its 6 week duration. Participation through the Engage BC online survey has yielded over 450 surveys completed to date in addition to email and mail submissions. In order to ensure British Columbians are aware of this process and have time to provide thoughtful and informed feedback, we have completed the following:

- 1) The engagement process is now extended by two weeks and will now conclude on July 14<sup>th</sup>, 2021.
