## Project overview

- Coastal GasLink is a fully permitted pipeline to deliver natural gas to LNG Canada's facility.
- 670-kilometres in length, spanning from northeastern B.C. to Kitimat
- Approved initial capacity of 2.1 billion cubic feet per day, with potential future capacity of 5 billion cubic feet per day.



## 2021 Project milestones to date

- Completed 100% of the pipe delivery across the route
- Welcomed Ledcor-Haisla Limited Partnership to Coastal GasLink
- Completed 100% of the clearing within the Peace River Regional District

# 2021 Construction status in Work Package 1

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## Mainline

- 140 kms ROW cleared **100%**
- Approximately 80 kms of pipe installed **57%**
- Murray River HDD

- Civil works, including piping/structural installation
- Compressor unit delivery and receipt

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# Wilde Lake Compressor Station

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## 2021 Forward looking construction in Work Package 1

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### Mainline

- Start and complete the Sukunka River HDD
- 50 km of pipeline installation
- Final clean up and reclamation activities for 65 km of the route in Work Package 1

### Wilde Lake Compressor Station

- Complete all concrete work
- Complete all heavy earthworks
- Start the physical construction of the compressor building





## Safety is our number one value

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- Bi-weekly COVID-19 briefings and regular reporting on [coastalgaslink.com](https://coastalgaslink.com)
- Robust COVID-19 Management Plan and “Zero is Real” campaign with our workers
- 4000+ asymptomatic PCR tests administered to date and introducing rapid testing program for Summer 2021 season
- AstraZeneca doses deployed under direction of Northern Health. Over 1000 workers have received their first dose of the vaccine to date and vaccination program has resumed

## Opportunities for recovery, and for the long term

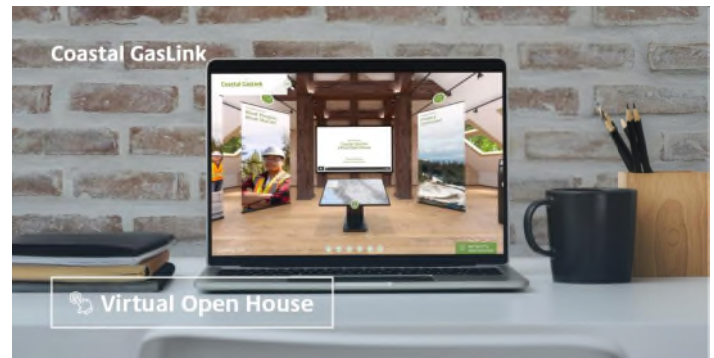
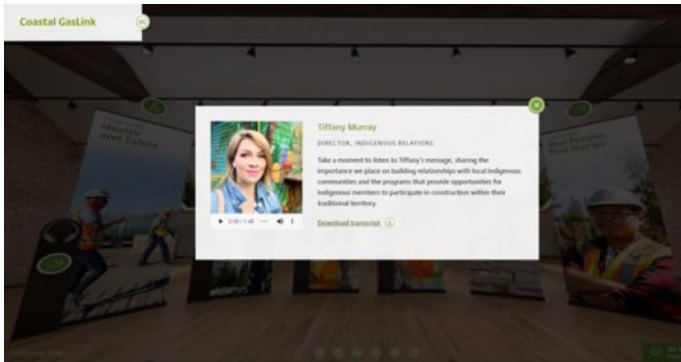
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- \$1.25 billion in Indigenous & local contracting opportunities awarded to date
