## PEACE RIVER REGIONAL DISTRICT Bylaw No. 2463, 2021

A bylaw to amend "Solid Waste Regulation and Fees Bylaw No. 2065, 2013" as previously amended by Bylaw 2342, 2018 and 2410, 2020.

WHEREAS, the Regional Board of the Peace River Regional District did, pursuant to the Province of British Columbia *Local Government Act*, adopt "Solid Waste Regulations and Fees Bylaw No. 2065, 2013";

AND WHEREAS, the Regional Board is desirous of changing landfill user behavior to increase the sorting of waste prior to its delivery to landfills, to further the goal of diversion and saved airspace at regional landfills ;

AND WHEREAS increased tipping fees charged on the deposit of unsorted industrial, commercial, and institutional waste will motivate and incentivize landfill users to sort waste prior to delivery to landfills;

NOW THEREFORE the Regional Board of the Peace River Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

### ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS:

- 1. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Solid Waste Regulations and Fees Amendment Bylaw No. 2463, 2021."
- 2. If any portion of this bylaw is declared invalid by a court, the invalid portion shall be severed and the remainder of the bylaw is deemed valid.
- 3. The headings used in this bylaw are for convenience only and do not form part of this bylaw, and are not to be used in the interpretation of this bylaw.
- 4. This bylaw shall be effective March 1, 2022, or upon adoption following receipt of approval from the Ministry of Environment and Climate Change, whichever is later.

#### **AMENDMENTS:**

Solid Waste Regulations and Fees Bylaw No. 2065, 2013" is hereby amended as follows:

5. **PART I – INTERPRETATION**, Definitions is amended by inserting the following new definitions in alphabetical order:

#### "Fall Cleanup"

means the period identified by the Regional Board for property cleanup each year between September 1<sup>st</sup> and November 30<sup>th</sup>, during which time, tipping fees will be waived for sorted and self hauled waste originating from a private property.

### "Spring Cleanup"

means the period identified by the Regional Board for property cleanup each year between March 1<sup>st</sup> and June 30<sup>th</sup>, during which time, tipping fees will be waived for sorted and self hauled waste originating from a private property.

- 6. **PART V CHARGES** is amended by inserting new clause 36 which reads as follows:
  - 36. Notwithstanding Clauses 31-35 above, in the event that the Regional Board identifies a Spring Cleanup or a Fall Cleanup, tipping fees will not be assessed/charged for self hauled waste originating from private property during the Spring Cleanup or Fall Cleanup period.

and all subsequent clauses are renumbered accordingly.

- 7. Schedule 'A' to Bylaw 2065 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with 'Schedule 'A' Fees and Charges by Weight' attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw.
- 8. Schedule 'B' to Bylaw 2065 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with 'Schedule 'B' Fees and Charges by Volume' attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw.
