

**PEACE RIVER REGIONAL DISTRICT**  
**Bylaw No. 2342, 2018**

A bylaw to amend "Solid Waste Regulation Bylaw No. 2065, 2013."

WHEREAS the Province of British Columbia has mandated that the Peace River Regional District undertake Solid Waste Management;

AND WHEREAS the Peace River Regional District has, by bylaw, established regional solid waste management as a local service pursuant to the *Local Government Act*;

AND WHEREAS the Peace River Regional District has adopted Solid Waste Regulation Bylaw No. 2065, 2013 to establish regulations for the disposal of solid waste within the Peace River Regional District and wishes to amend Bylaw No. 2065, 2013 to remove the requirement for loads entering PRRD landfills and transfer sites to be secured; and to add the authority to impose fees for the disposal of solid waste;

AND WHEREAS the Regional Board has adopted Solid Waste Disposal Fee Bylaw No. 2053, 2013 and wishes to repeal it once the authority to impose fees are included in Bylaw 2065, 2013.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of the Peace River Regional District in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

**ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS:**

1. This Bylaw may be cited as "Solid Waste Regulation Amendment Bylaw No. 2342, 2018."

**TEXT AMENDMENTS TO SOLID WASTE REGULATON BYLAW NO. 2065, 2013:**

**In the Preamble Section :**

2.
  - 2.1 After the word "regulations", insert "and fees".
  - 2.2 In the second WHEREAS paragraph, delete all words after *Local Government Act*.

**In PART 1 – INTERPRETATION**

3. Definitions:
  - 3.1 Amend the definition of "**Authorized Landfill Site**" by inserting the words 'or operational certificate' after the word 'permit'.
  - 3.2 Delete the definition of "**Condemned Foods**" in its entirety.
  - 3.3 Amend the definition of "**Prohibited Waste**" by deleting the words 'Unplugged Small Appliance Recycling Program' and replacing them with 'ElectroRecycle Program™'.
  - 3.4 Delete 'a) condemned foods' from the definition of "**Restricted Waste**".
  - 3.5 Delete the definition of "**Unsecured Load**" in its entirety.

**In Part V - CHARGES**

4.
  - 4.1 Insert at end of clause 31 a new sentence: "Every person disposing of Solid Waste at a transfer station or a landfill site shall pay the applicable fees and charges to the Regional District as set out in the attached Schedules 'A' through 'C'."
  - 4.2 Insert end of clause 32 a new sentence: "At landfill or transfer station locations where there are no scales, or in the event that the scales are not operational, the fees payable shall be as set out in Schedule B, and if applicable, Schedule C.
  - 4.3 In Clause 33, delete the words "Solid Waste Disposal Fee Bylaw No. 2053, 2013 and replace them with the words "Schedule A - Fees and Charges by Weight, or Schedule B – Fees and Charges by

Volume, as applicable,, and Schedule C – Miscellaneous Charges, all of which are attached hereto and form part of this bylaw”.

4.4 Delete Clauses 36 and 37 in their entirety and renumber all subsequent clauses accordingly.

**General**

5. Replace all occurrences of the words “Waste Management Act” with “*Environmental Management Act*”.

**In PART VII – MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS:**

**6. Repeal**

In Clause 38 renumber the existing sentence as a) and insert the following new sentences as b) and c):

b) Solid Waste Disposal Fee Bylaw No. 1900, 2010 is hereby repealed.

c) Solid Waste Disposal Fee Bylaw No. 2053, 2013 is hereby repealed

**7. Title**

7.1 In the title section, Clause 39, and also in every other occurrence in the bylaw, delete all references to ‘Solid Waste Regulation Bylaw No. 2065, 2013’ and replace with ‘Solid Waste Regulation and Fees Bylaw No. 2065, 2013’.

**8. Schedules**

Insert the attached Schedules A, B, and C into Bylaw 2065, 2013.

Insert new section after Title Clause 39 in Part VII – Miscellaneous Provisions that reads as follows:
