That the Regional Board authorize the conversion of Supplementary Letter Patent #45 (Sub-Regional Recreation and Cultural Services) into a service establishment bylaw.

BACKGROUND/RATIONALE:

The Regional Board considered the resolution above during its consideration of the report titled 'August 20, 2020 Closed Electoral Area Directors Committee Meeting Recommendation, ADM-BRD-069', which is attached for the Board's information. Voting on the resolution was deferred until such time as Director Michetti, Village of Pouce Coupe, had the opportunity to discuss the proposed conversion with the Village of Pouce Coupe Council.

Supplementary Letter Patent #45 (Sub-Regional Recreation and Cultural Services) was established on October 31, 1967. Participating members include the City of Dawson Creek, Village of Pouce Coupe, and defined portions of Electoral Areas D and E. The Supplementary Letter Patent authorizes the provision of funding from portions of the PRRD toward operational costs of recreational facilities within the participating members' boundaries.
