1. Purpose

1.1 The purpose of this Policy is to establish an expectation for the Board, staff, and the public, that the Board will strive to be as transparent as possible with the business of the Peace River Regional District. Careful consideration will be given to which items are discussed in a Closed Meeting, and any items that can be released from a confidential meeting, once finalized, will be routinely and proactively released, with approval from the Board.

2. Scope

2.1 As the provisions of the *Community Charter* and the Peace River Regional District Board Procedure Bylaw apply to Board meetings, Committees, and Commissions of the Board, this Policy shall also apply across the spectrum of Regular Board Meetings and all Committees and Commissions appointed by the Peace River Regional District.

4. Policy

- 4.1 The Peace River Regional District will carefully and deliberately consider issues that **may** be discussed in a Closed to the Public meeting, and if necessary, will recess to a closed session to deliberate whether an item shall be discussed in a closed to the public or open session.
- 4.2 The Board directs the routine and proactive release of any decisions made in a closed meeting that can be released to the public.
