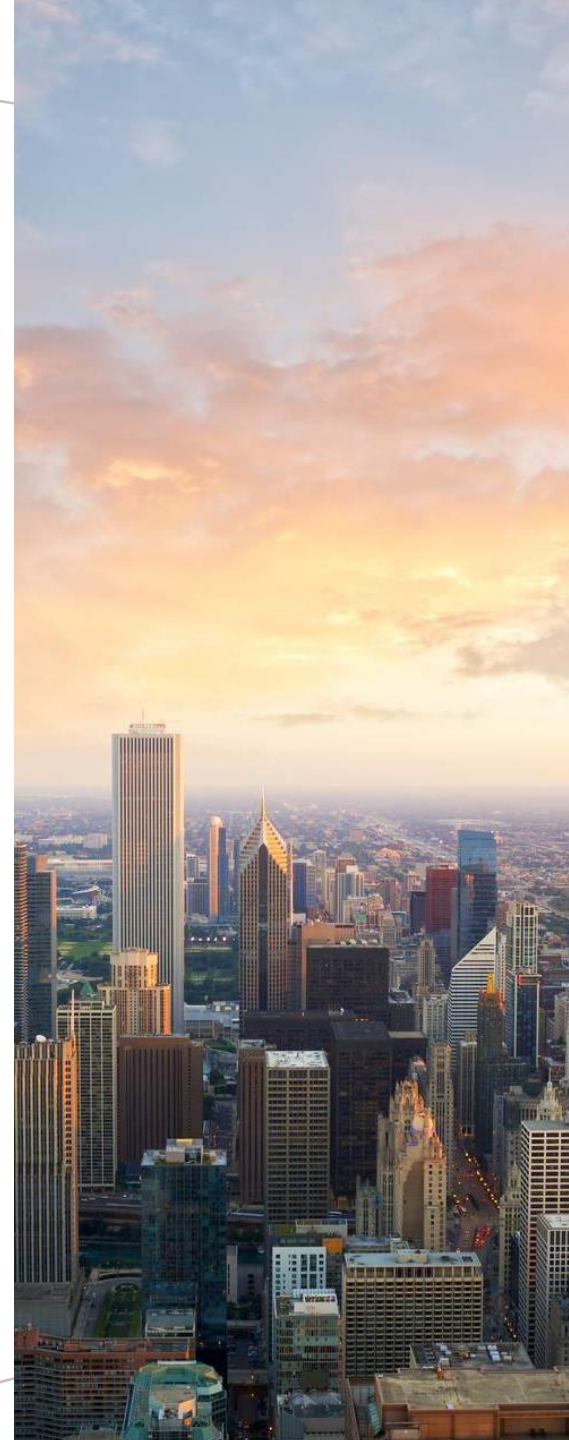

BULTERY'S HOUSE

The Butlerys House serves as a sanctuary, offering a 6-bedroom, 4 ½-bathroom accommodation for individuals seeking medical assistance in Dawson Creek. It provides a comforting environment, especially for those facing challenges such as maternity, oncology, and surgery. Managing medical needs alongside accommodation and meal costs can be a complex endeavor. The facility requires round the clock support for reservation management, cleaning duties, and laundry services, all of which entail significant expenses. Guests are charged \$30.00 per night, with additional costs covered by a grant from the Province or through fundraising efforts by the Society. Gratitude is extended to the Peace River Regional District (PRRD) for instrumental support to achieve the success of the facility

LOCUM HOUSE

Located at 1608 106th Ave, this asset is utilized by Northern Health to house visiting Locums at no cost. It is a 1 bedroom, 1 bathroom house that the society has leased from the city of Dawson Creek. The SPHSS cleans and maintains the residence along with providing snow clearing during the winter. Northern Health manages bookings.

To date we have accommodated 9 doctor stays for a total of 57 nights since opening in August 2023.

CARRIAGE HOUSE

The carriage house is a small unit on the same property as the Bulterys House that we lease to Northern Health to generate a small income to the society.

RECRUITMENT AND RETENTION INITIATIVES

These events are tailored to each community to show our appreciation of the hard work healthcare professionals do.

In Dawson Creek we hosted 3 evening events where Nurses, Doctors, specialists and others were able to socialize outside of work and know that the community appreciates them for what they all do for our communities.

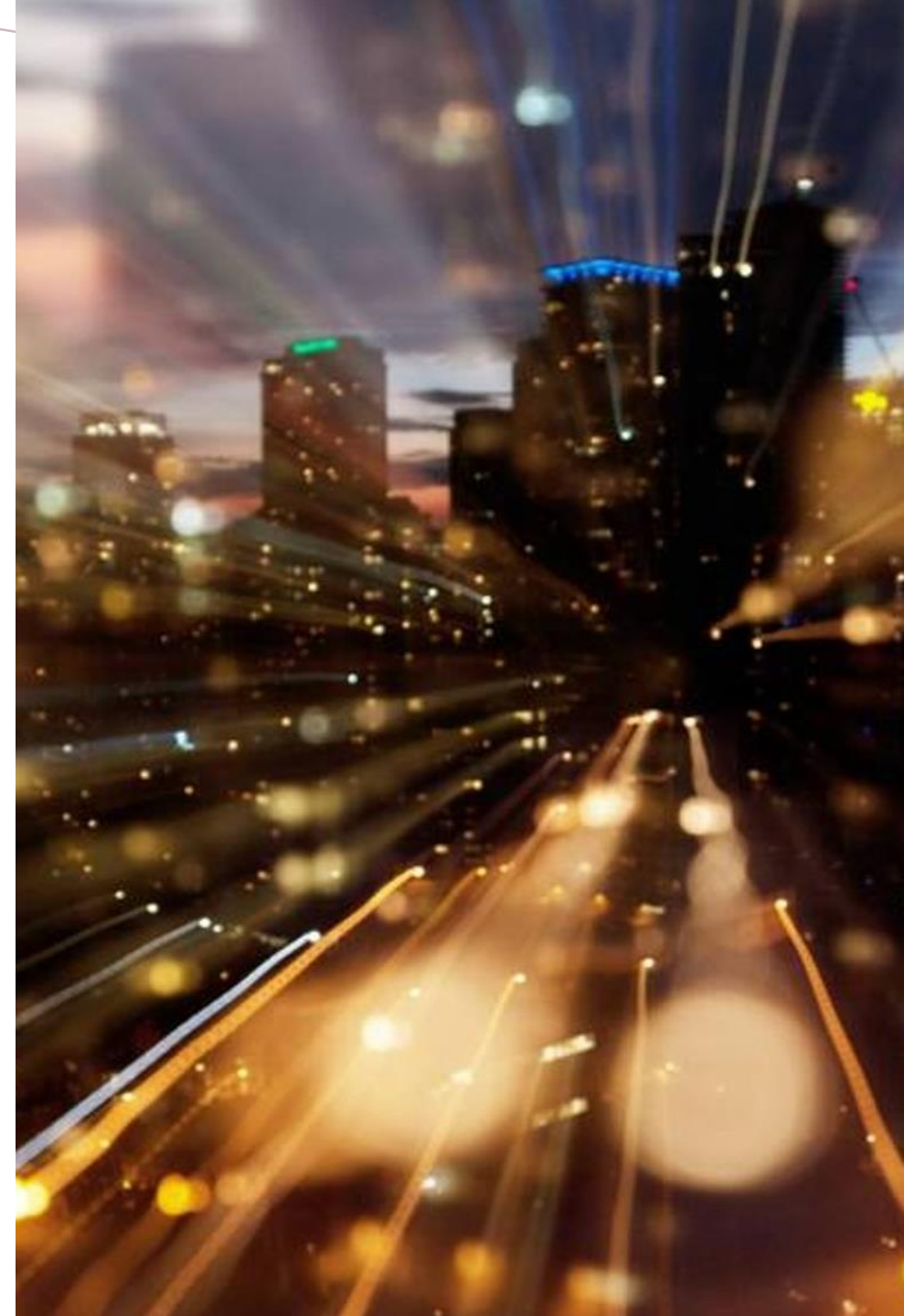
In Tumbler Ridge we hosted 2 lunches for the Health Centre and invited nurses, doctors, BC ambulance, and support staff to attend.
