Subject: Broadband Internet and Mobility Committee Recommendation to the Regional Board

The following recommendation from the Broadband Internet and Mobility Committee meeting held on April 24, 2024 is presented to the Regional Board for consideration:

RECOMMENDATION: [Corporate Weighted]

That the Regional Board award the contract for "Regional Connectivity Strategy Report RFP 12-2024" to Planetworks Consulting Corp. at the cost of \$92,740 (excluding taxes); further that the Chair and Chief Administrative Officer be authorized to sign the contract on behalf of the Peace River Regional District.

BACKGROUND/RATIONALE:

On February 22, 2024, the Regional Board approved the following resolution:

MOVED, SECONDED and CARRIED,

That the Regional Board authorize staff to initiate a public procurement to source external expertise to collaborate with stakeholders to collect, revise and update data and develop a high-level design for the Peace River Regional District 2024 Regional Connectivity Strategy Report.

On March 11, 2024, the Peace River Regional District (PRRD) issued a Request for Proposal (RFP) seeking qualified consulting companies to submit proposals to complete an update of the Regional Connectivity Strategy. The RFP sought to identify a consulting firm able to undertake a comprehensive research and engagement initiative aimed at producing an updated Regional Connectivity Strategy Report. This revised report will assess the present connectivity landscape within the region, identify service deficiencies, propose remedial measures, and establish connectivity benchmarks and objectives for each Electoral Area, member municipality, and First Nation entity. Moreover, the report will outline specific technological solutions and potential funding frameworks geared towards enhancing services for underserved communities

Using interviews, they will gather comprehensive data on connectivity needs, challenges, and desired improvements from PRRD Directors, local businesses, First Nation communities and PRRD residents.

This data will be included in a detailed report outlining stakeholder input, key insights, and specific recommendations for enhancing internet connectivity. The report may include proposed strategies to support stakeholders in collaboratively achieving improved connectivity in their region.
