Subject: Proposal for Collaboration on Director / Board Training for Non-Profit Organizations

At the District of Tumbler Ridge's Policies and Priorities Committee (PPC) meeting held on December 9th, 2024, Council passed a motion to have staff explore whether the Peace River Regional District would be interested in collaborating on or leading efforts to develop and provide Director/Board Training for Nonprofit Organizations. This training could be offered annually/ bi-annually at various locations throughout the PRRD to ensure any boards/directors from any non-profits in any of the member municipalities or within various locations throughout the PRRD have the ability or opportunity to participate.
