Hi Crystal,

The Overpass Road and 97N intersection has 3 luminaires illuminating the intersection to ensure visibility at night of turning vehicles. The highway segment in this area is classified as undivided, rural highway and would not typically be fully illuminated as corridors through towns are often. The reason why the corner is "darker" is the motorist moving from an illuminated area into an unilluminated segment and the adjustment time for the eyes gives the perception of extra darkness. Corridor illumination requests go through our Regional Engineering group at the request of the District. From my experience it is very hard to get the engineering support and warrants for extra and new illumination, as there are some very firm engineering guidelines that govern when and where luminaires are warranted.

MOTI has instructed our contractor to install more reflective markers on the overhead itself to highlight the structure edges.

I have included our District Program Manager and Operations Manager in this e-mail chain, they will add the request to our program list for review for Region and program decision based on the engineering warrant review.
