Thank you for providing a final report and financial summary for the above noted project. We have reviewed your submission and all reporting requirements have been met.

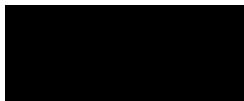

This amount represents full payment of the grant and is based on 100% of the total reported expenditure, less the initial payment of \$27,016 issued March 2023 and the payment of \$2,984.00 issued March 2024.
