Thank you for providing a final report and financial summary for the above noted project. We have reviewed your submission and all reporting requirements have been met.

The final report notes a total eligible expenditure of \$54,032.00. Based on this, a payment in the amount of \$24,032.00 will follow via electronic fund transfer. This amount represents full payment of the grant and is based on 100% of the total reported expenditure, less the initial payment of \$27,016 issued March 2023 and the payment of \$2,984.00 issued March 2024.

I would like to congratulate the Peace River Regional District for undertaking this significant project and responding to the opportunity to enhance volunteer and composite fire departments' capacity to provide fire protection services, and increase the resiliency of BC communities.
