I have attached a sample tour plan (below) that can be adjusted based on what PRRD officials (and staff, subject to capacity limitations) are most interested in.

Potential dates:

- July 28/ 29/ 30/ 31
  - Note - depending on the level of interest, it may not be possible for Ovintiv to mobilize logistics quickly enough for these dates following the July 17<sup>th</sup> PRRD Board meeting.
- September 10/ 11/ 17/ 18
  - Note, September 10 & 11<sup>th</sup> are the only available dates when we will also have completions (hydraulic fracturing) operations running in the area; any of the tour stops in the sample tour plan could be swapped out for a completions site tour if desired.
- October 1/ 2

1. Please confirm whether there is interest in pursuing a tour, and indicate which of the above dates would be amenable (more than one option, if possible).
2. Please provide a rough count of participants.
3. Please provide feedback on the sample tour plan, what activities are of interest/ not.
