Library Director – Christmas planning; ideas are in the works for our seniors and Elders including having ChetTV to do a video, promoting our Christmas kits, and zoom activities. Paperwork with PRRD is complete to hold the Good Food Community Kitchen at the Moberly Lake Hall. The technology upgrade is almost complete. Alexander Security was on site for the annual inspection. Update on meetings with: NELF, CALP, DECODA, library staff, ABCPLD and professional development sessions, Grants and funding, library timeline since the March 18th closure, and staff notes.

(NELF) North East Library Federation Representative – Will be having a meeting tomorrow about NELF having its own Advantage Collection for Overdrive. This is where all the NELF libraries will share their own audio books and e-books in hopes to shorten the waiting time.

District of Chetwynd – the District of Chetwynd has a new Fire Chief, Dan Golog, who will be starting on December 15th.
