Cariboo Regional District	Applicants must fill out a Contaminated Site Declaration form. Will charge the \$100 fee if a Site Disclosure Statement is required.
Regional District of Fraser Fort George	Applicants must fill out a Contaminated Site Waiver form. Do not charge any fee yet.
Northern Rockies Regional Municipality	Currently in the process of developing their procedure for this process. (Reviewed one file late last year but did not charge any fee.)
City of Fort St. John	Get applicants to fill out the Ministry's site profile. Do not charge any fee.
City of Dawson Creek	Get applicants to fill out the Ministry's site profile. Do not charge any fee.
District of Tumbler Ridge	Do not have a current practice for the process.
District of Hudson's Hope	Do not have a current practice for the process.
District of Taylor	Currently, do not have an approach for this process. Will discuss with the Council. Will be inclined to charge fee if it increases the workload. Requested PRRD staff to share their finalized decision and procedure with them.
District of Chetwynd	Get applicants to sign a 'declaration'. Do not charge any fee currently and will not charge in the future too.
Village of Pouce Coupe	Currently, do not have an approach for this process. Will discuss with the Council.
