Following up on my letter of June 26, 2020, I am pleased to let you know that Tsaa Nuna Conservancy was established by Order in Council on September 20, 2020. The 5,306-hectare conservancy along the southern shore of the Halfway River is intended to provide for the conservation of the high cultural and natural values associated with the area. Establishing Tsaa Nuna Conservancy was a key recommendation of the Government-to-Government Agreement with Halfway River First Nation, signed in 2017.

A news release regarding this protected area establishment is forthcoming shortly.
