RE: Traffic Safety on Braden Road and Surrounding Area

At its January 14, 2021 meeting, the Peace River Regional District Board discussed traffic safety on the Braden Road and at intersections in the surrounding area.

Intersections at the Braden Road and surrounding area are marked by simple stop signs which are not clearly visible to motorists entering the highway and has resulted in numerous accidents, near misses, and a recent fatality. In the interest of enhanced safety for motorists in the Region, the Board respectfully requests that flashing lights be attached to existing stop signs to provide higher visibility for motorists, and that rumble strips be installed to alert drivers to highway intersection hazards.
