Subject: 2020 Rural Recreational and Cultural Grants-in-Aid - Eligibility Review

RECOMMENDATION #1:

That the Rural Budgets Administration Committee determine which 2020 Recreational and Cultural Grantsin-Aid applications are eligible to be considered for funding under the Recreational and Cultural GIA policy; further,

That the Committee invite those eligible applicants to attend the Spring Allocation meetings as scheduled below:

Electoral Area 'B' and 'C'	April 20, 2020	Cecil Lake Community Hall
Electoral Area 'E' West	April 21, 2020	Chetwynd & District Recreation Centre
South Peace Sub-Regional	April 22, 2020	Cutbank Community Hall

RECOMMENDATION #2:

That the Rural Budgets Administration Committee determine which grant applications, if any, will be provided with a grant through alternative funding options; further, that should the Committee authorize any such grants that the appropriate funding source be identified.

BACKGROUND/RATIONALE:

The purpose of this report is to provide the Rural Budgets Administration Committee with the necessary information to determine the merit and eligibility for funding of each Recreational and Cultural Grants-in-Aid (GIA) application. Staff have reviewed each applicant's not-for-profit status, financial request, project details, and provided all supporting documentation. This information, along with potential alternate funding options and staff assessment notes, has been compiled for the Committee in the attached Summary of Applications sheets.

In prior years, the Electoral Area Directors for Area E and Sub-Regional pre-allocated a percentage of requested grant amounts to each eligible applicant before the spring allocation meetings, leaving only a portion of the total allocation budget to be distributed collectively. The attached summary sheets for Area E and Sub-Regional include an additional column for pre-allocated amounts, calculated at 75% for requests equal to or less than \$10,000, or 50% for requests greater than \$10,000. Electoral Area Directors for Area B and Area C have chosen to allocate 100% of the total budget allocation collectively at the spring allocation meetings.

This year, the Regional District received a total of 41 GIA applications and a total request for funding of \$794,121.43. The total amount requested in Electoral Area B is \$283,357.03, Electoral Area C is \$81,915.30, Electoral Area E is \$191,647.73 and South Peace Sub-Regional is \$237,201.37.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATION(S):

Each year, the Electoral Area Directors determine a budget amount to be allocated for Recreational and Cultural GIA as part of the budget process. The 2020 amounts listed below will be included as a commitment in Recreation and Cultural Facilities Grant, Function 280(F280) and Sub-Regional Recreation, Function 221 (F221), as part of the 2020 Draft Budget scheduled to be ratified by the Regional Board on March 26th, 2020.

- \$130,000 Electoral Area B (F280)
- \$ 50,000 Electoral Area C (F280)
- \$103,000 Electoral Area E (F280)
- \$200,000 South Peace Sub-Regional (F221)
