On April 12, NCLGA President Sarrah Storey will attend an engagement session hosted by Minister of State Nathan Cullen. The purpose of the session is to help determine whether land use objectives that support economic activity, environmental sustainability and reconciliation with Indigenous peoples can be more effectively achieved through ministry restructuring. To prepare for the session, participants have been asked to consider the following 3 questions:

1. What is working well today in your interactions with the Ministry of Forests, Lands, Natural Resource Operations and Rural Development, and the natural resource sector ministries?
2. What are the main challenges facing your organization in working with the government's natural resource sector ministries?
3. If you could change one thing, what would that be and why?
