Subject: ITT Award 26-2024 - Bessborough Landfill Phase 4A Construction

RECOMMENDATION: [Corporate Weighted]

That the Regional Board award Invitation to Tender 26-2024 "Bessborough Landfill Phase 4A Construction" to KBL Projects Limited at a cost of \$2,034,330.00 (excluding taxes); further, that the Chair and Chief Administration Officer be authorized to sign the contract on behalf of the Peace River Regional District.

BACKGROUND/RATIONALE:

The Design Operating and Closure Plan (DOCP) for the Bessborough Landfill outlines how the development of the landfill will proceed over the next ten years. In the current DOCP, filling of Phase 4A is scheduled to begin in 2025.

On December 1, 2022, staff brought forward a supplemental request and business case to the Solid Waste Committee Meeting which outlined the need to secure engineering services in 2023 and construction services in 2024. The supplemental request for the project was approved by the Regional Board on December 9, 2022, and engineering costs were included in the 2023 Solid Waste Capital Budget.

In 2023, the PRRD issued a Request for Proposal (RFP) for engineering services, which was awarded to Tetra Tech Canada Inc (Tetra Tech) during the May 4, 2023 Regional Board Meeting. Through 2023, Tetra Tech worked on a geotechnical investigation, design package, construction cost estimates, and tender documents in preparation for the construction of the Phase 4A cell to be tendered in 2024.

On March 4, 2024 staff issued an Invitation to Tender (ITT) to acquire the best pricing for construction services for the Phase 4A cell at the Bessborough Landfill. Eleven bids were received, each proponent was evaluated based on work schedule, general experience, project experience, references and project budget the results of the evaluation matrix are provided below:

Ten submissions met the mandatory requirements of the ITT. Based on the scoring matrix above, KBL Projects Ltd. is the preferred proponent.

STRATEGIC PLAN RELEVANCE:

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATION(S):

Through the 2024 budget process, \$2,356,604 was allocated to the Bessborough Landfill project. This includes \$106,604 for engineering services and \$2,250,000 for construction costs.

The bid received from KBL Projects Ltd. is \$2,034,330.00, which includes a 20% contingency. This puts the project \$215,670 under the budgeted amount. Table 1 below provides a summary of the budgeted versus awarded contract values for capital costs.
